

# Thank you for helping displaced families in Sudan



With your help Partners International was able to distribute food, blankets, mosquito nets and soap to 3,100 displaced families living in temporary camps in Sudan. In all 326 Canadian donors provided \$52,658 to support the relief efforts of our local partner, the African Inland Church (AIC).

In April, AIC evangelists consulted with local leaders in the camps and chose to help 2,500 families in most need — those without shelter, female-headed households, widows with children and families with sick members. An additional distribution was completed this past August to another 600 families.

AIC has been working with the majority Muslim population in Darfur since 1980. For 20 years they were met with hostility, people often throwing stones at their evangelists. AIC evangelists continued to share the love of Jesus and minister to physical needs, especially since this crisis that began in 2003.

“Because of your continued support for the people of Sudan, many people have given their lives to Christ Jesus,” said Rev. Kongi. “For when they came for help they were relieved, not only with food but also introduced to the Provider of all things.”
