## Reaching Peru's most remote mountain villages

Two hundred kilometres from Lima and 14,000 feet up the Andes mountains in central Peru, live more than 100,000 mostly unreached highland Quechua people. The majority of the people are illiterate and cling to life at a subsistence level. Few Spanish-speaking Peruvian churches possess a vision or the means for reaching this large group of unevangelized people.

## Bringing hope and health to Quechua people

The Psalmistas Missionary Association (PMA) is one of few indigenous organizations committed to taking the Good News to highland Quechua in Peru. The ministry targets 800 of the region's villages which remain unreached.

- Work in mountain villages often begins by serving the physical needs of people. PMA works with a community to provide clean water and sanitation and help increase family incomes with agricultural programs and small businesses such as raising guinea pigs.
- Compassionate response to physical needs open the door to share the story of Jesus with the community, organize home study groups and ultimately start a church. The ministry has planted several churches in this fashion.
- Leadership training is also a major focus for the ministry since most of the region's 90 churches are without pastoral leadership.
